Flashlights
Camp chairs

Class A Scout Uniform (blue shirt, neckerchief, hat-optional)
Class B tee shirt
Rain Gear
Warm Jacket, Sweatshirt
Complete change of clothes (1 set per day)
Hat
Something warm to sleep in (sweats and a ski cap)
Insect repellent
Sun screen

Toiletries

Small hand towel
Toothbrush & toothpaste
Toilet Paper
Kleenex

Optional Items

Camera
Sunglasses
Walking Stick
Back Pack
Frisbee, ball (no footballs)

Electronics
